SOME REVIEWERS OF this music album have merely quoted the sleeve notes, describing it as "a wonderfully evocative musical representation of the events of 1940" and a "fusion of musical styles from contemporary to classical". These descriptions might be accurate enough, but they do not perhaps give a true understanding of just what this product is. In my opinion it is one of the most individually creative products with a Battle of Britain theme that has been produced for many years, and is perhaps more clearly described as a mix between *War of the Worlds* and a Jean Michelle-Jarre album, all centred on the Battle. I was fascinated by producer Steve Bowe's musical progress of the Battle, with more sinister tunes for the tracks representing the darker themes and livelier tunes for the more victorious ones. Track titles include *Gathering Storm*, *Scramble*, *Engage*, *Up With the Angels* and *Count Them In*; you can hear sample excerpts via the on-line preview. I would encourage anyone to listen to this brilliant production for their journeys to and from Battle of Britain commemorations around September 15 this year, and Remembrance Day in November. It is a truly innovative tribute to the memories of the Allied airmen who fought that crucial conflict, and just the most inspiring piece of music I have heard for years. JC
